What these figures mean is that roughly 10% of the population of the Huon enlisted for the Great War and just over 80% of them returned, either whole or wounded.

Approx 1 in every 5 enlisted servicemen were killed in action, including soldiers, sailors, airmen, nurses, doctors and chaplains.

They generally served at Gallipoli, Alexandria, Tel-el-Kebir, England, France and Belgium.

Those that died, amounted to about 2% of the entire population of the Huon.
